Get full details including updated opt-out information at dan boater.org/abc. To decline these benefits, primary active members should go to the USPS webpage (https://www.usps.org/cgi-bin-nat/tools/myprofile.cgi), log in to their Member Profile, scroll down to "Receive DAN Boater Benefits" and click "No." To accept these free benefits, you don't need to do a thing. You and your family will receive valuable travel safety benefits from DAN Boater until your next dues renewal. When renewing your annual membership online, you can choose to continue these valuable travel safety benefits as part of your individual or family membership for only \$25 per year or decline them at checkout. These emergency travel benefits are available whenever more than 50 miles from home and you do not need to be boating.




