





Dope everyone had a happy holiday and managed to see family and friends if only by technology!

With coming of a new year comes thoughts of more boating. We are out boating as I write this, but for some boating may be paused for awhile. So, what better time to take an educational boating class! Lots of classes are being offered virtually from Boat Handling to Navigation by different squadrons so anyone from the Tacoma area can take a class from Friday Harbor to Beaverton and beyond. We recently proctored Boat Handling exams given by Beaverton Power Squadron for several people in Pierce County. Check out the link below for classes available in District 16 and Beaverton.

The first one on the list is Advanced Piloting given by Gary Ball. Gary recently taught Piloting for our squadron and will be teaching Advanced Piloting starting January 21 for 8 weeks. AP teaches you to use radar, chart plotters, AIS, and other electronic tools to supplement basic GPS navigation. Obtain a thorough understanding of piloting techniques in a variety of coastal tide, current, and wind conditions.

What's included?

- Advanced positioning techniques, such as advancing a line of position to obtain a running fix
- Use of a variety of electronic tools: radar, depth sounders, autopilots, chart plotters, laptop computer software, and more
- Hazard avoidance techniques using electronics (e.g. avoidance waypoints or safety zones in GPS)
- Collision avoidance using radar, GPS, and AIS
- Working with the tide and current data to determine clearances, depth of water, and effects of current
- Piloting in various wind and current conditions
- The "Seaman's Eye" simple skills for checking that one is on course

Interested in Cruise Planning? There is something very special about the thrill of cruising in new waters and the sense of accomplishment upon completing an extended cruise. To go beyond what most boaters do on a weekend overnight or even a week or so. Marina hopping requires boaters to leave their normal cruising areas and comfort zones. The Cruising and Cruise Planning course focuses on the planning and preparation necessary for safe enjoyable extended cruises on both inland and coastal waters.

Designed for members who cruise on either a sail or powerboat (owned or chartered)—this course covers the following topics:

- Cruise preparation and planning General
- Boat and Equipment
- Anchors and Anchoring
- Security
- Chartering
- Cruising Outside the United States
- Crew and Provisioning
