Lello fellow boaters.

Well, it's time to start getting ready for boating season. It may be a little early yet, but it's not that far away. Time to check out your electronics for proper function, get the engine tuned up and outdrive serviced if you haven't yet. Do you need new bottom paint? Do those lines need replacing that were looking pretty sad last time out on the boat? Remember to give your boat a thorough going over, before you go. Did you purchase a new boat? If so, have you updated your float plan information with the people you leave it with? There is a lot to think about when you own a boat.

I attended the National Virtual Governing Board Meeting on Feb 20, and came away with a lot to think about. The United States Power Squadron is roughly 25% of the size now that it was 20 years ago. There has been a slow decline in membership for several years now. It is not just USPS that has this problem. I have personally witnessed this firsthand in several organizations that I am active in. People just don't join organizations like they used to, whether it's Churches, the Kiwanis club, PTA, boating groups, or car clubs. Due to lower member numbers, finances are tighter than ever at the National level. I bring this up not to spread doom and gloom, but to let you know there will be changes happening. Some have already occurred, for instance there is no longer an inventory in the ships store sitting on the shelf. Everything is made to order and then shipped directly to you. Many changes have yet to be determined, just be aware they will be coming, and should make our organization stronger and more adaptable to change.

One thing that was great to hear was that despite all of the problems related to covid-19, ABC classes across the nation are up in numbers, as there has been a large influx of first-time boaters. Also, with the virtual classes it's more accessible to people whose schedule would otherwise keep them from taking classes. If you want to take a class that Tacoma is not currently conducting, it's now possible to take one virtually from another Squadron that does have the class, even if it's clear across the Nation. Our website, Wake Astern, and Education Dept. are working hard to keep you aware of educational opportunities that are available.

The next National Governing Board will be August 25 – September 5. Plan now to virtually attend and see what new ideas are coming our way. Also remember that the District 16 Spring Governing Board and C.O.W. Will be virtual and will be on Saturday March 13. Tune in and see what's going on at the District level. I'm hearing some interesting things are on the Horizon. Also, D16 plans to have our annual District Rendezvous at Poulsbo on June 11 - 13, so mark it on your calendar now. There will be some changes. At this time, there will be no group dinner, or meetings. We will just be sharing fellowship with our brother and sister boaters.

Here at home, I would like to extend kudos to several people from our Squadron. P/C Larry Warren has been asked by National if they could reprint his article about our Toy and Food Drive in The Ensign. District 16 ran it in the recent Cardinal Points also. Our ASEO Sandi Carroll earned her 25th Merit Mark in 2020 and is now a Life Member, congratulations Sandi. P/C Jim and Debbie Harden made the National Co-op Charting Honor Roll. Ask Jim, our incoming Exec Officer for 2021, how they did it, he'd be happy to fill you in. Last but not least, our website and The Wake Astern both received awards for their excellence in 2020.






