

That's the latest for now from your Educational Department. Otto, Bentley and Sandi.











They can make individual reservations during office hours, or can start partial reservations any time after the office closes.

<u>Slip Assignment</u>: Dock Street Marina will create the moorage layout based on the amount of boats signed up. They will email the layout to you early in the week of your arrival.

<u>Cancellations:</u> Individual reservation cancellations must be made by contacting the marina office <u>24 Hours</u> prior to arrival date. Any reservations that are not cancelled 24 hours prior to arrival date may be subject to having 1 night of moorage charged.

<u>Check In:</u> Check-in time is 1:00 pm on the date of arrival. Earlier arrivals are allowed before 1:00pm as long as the boater has previously contacted and got a confirmation from the marina.

<u>Check Out:</u> Check out time is 12:00pm (noon) on the day of departure. Later departures are allowed after 12:00 pm as long as the boater has previously contacted and got a confirmation from the marina.


