

Cdr James Harden, JN-CN Annual Meeting in Florida next year. The National Executive Officer Ralph Bernard will be attending our District 16 Change of Watch on March 11th and I know he would love to meet you.

There were several items voted on from the meeting listed below:

- 1. The motion to reduce the National Finance Committee from having five (5) members, to read three to five members was defeated.
- 2. The motion to allow electronic voting at the national meetings which allows members to vote from their homes was approved. The process still needs some minor fixes, but it did work at the Annual Meeting this time.
- 3. The motion allowing fees and dues changes to only be voted on at the National Governing Board meeting in the fall was approved. This would align any increase of fees and dues with the national fiscal starting date of December 1st.
- 4. The motion to increase member dues was approved which haven't been increased for the last five years to:
 - \$5.00 per active member,
 - \$7.50 per active member with family membership, and
 - \$2.50 per active life member with family membership.

This increase helps the organization to keep up with inflation but not totally.

5. The motion by Houston Squadron through the resolution process was approved to provide all instructor course manuals in electronic form for free.

The meeting had a few other votes electing a new National Treasurer Shirley Heald and a new National Educational Officer Charles J. Wells. I also moved from the Budget Committee to the Finance Committee.

Thanks to the loosely formed COW Ad Hoc Committee, the menu, reservation form, date and time for our Squadron's 2023 Change of Watch has been set. You should be receiving your reservation soon by email. The squadron bridge is hoping all our members will attend this event on Wednesday, April 26th at the Tacoma Yacht Club, this being our 84th year. Doesn't that make you feel old.

Finally, I want to mention the 2023 Daffodil Parade at Tacoma Yacht Club on $14^{th} - 16^{th}$ of April. The squadron will be decorating our boat entry in the parade and needs volunteers to help decorate. Please contact Jackie Mattox if you wish to volunteer.



EDUCATIONAL DEPARTMENT



America's Boating Club of Tacoma and South Puget Sound is offering Advanced Piloting (Advanced Marina Navigation) via Zoom starting March 13th. All other classes will be on Tuesdays.

This is an 8-week course from 7pm-9pm. Completion of Piloting is recommended before taking Advanced Piloting. In this course, you will learn to use manual navigation, radar, chart plotters, AIS, and other electronic tools in a variety of coastal tides, current and wind conditions. Learn course planning, extended cruise navigation, hazard and collision avoidance, and navigational aids.

What's included?

- Advanced positioning techniques, such as advancing a line of position to obtain a running fix.
- Use of a variety of electronic tools: radar, depth sounders, autopilots, chart plotters, laptop computer software, and more
- Hazard avoidance techniques using electronics (e.g., avoidance waypoints or safety zones in GPS)
- Collision avoidance using radar, GPS, and AIS
- Working with the tide and current data to determine clearances, depth of water, and effects of current.
- Piloting in various wind and current conditions
- Simple skills for checking that one is on course.

Cost for this course is \$110 for non-members of America's Boating Club and \$80 for members providing you have the tools from the Piloting class.

America's Boating Course (ABC) will start April 24 at Day Island Yacht from 7 pm – 9 pm. There will be 3 in person classes on Mondays and one Zoom class plus the night of the exam. Passing the exam qualifies you for Washington State Boaters Card and discounts on insurance. All ages are encouraged to take this class.

America's Boating Course is the most comprehensive, single source, in-person boating course available to give you the skills you need to enjoy your time on the water and boat with confidence.

What You'll Learn:

- Information about your State Boating Laws, regulations, boat registration, and licensing.
- Required boating safety equipment.
- Dos and Don'ts of boating safely
- Practical Knowledge of navigation and rules of the road.
- How to handle medical emergencies onboard and mechanical problems on the water.
- The basics of towing and trailering
- Special important information for hunters, anglers, and sports enthusiasts.

National wants us to have 2 delegates. Will be Zoom meeting. Meeting starts at 6:00 am PST, but nothing happens for the first hour.


March 11 - District 16 COW. One day thing at Everett. We have 3 delegates attending.


