

# EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

We're almost upon our rendezvous season, a long-awaited time to connect with our fellow boaters. February usually is our kickoff month, and this year is no exception, with Arabella's being our first as usual.

If you have had a chance to look at the rendezvous scheduled for this year, you'll find at least one marina, not on the typical list of scheduled cruises. Longbranch Marina is a favorite place for most of us to cruise to. A little on the primitive side for some, but for the most part, a great place to gather in a beautiful setting with a fabulous view of Mt Rainier. For some of us, not wishing to break the law, this has put this marina on "out of bounds." As of May 10th, of last year, Filucy Bay has been declared a no-discharge zone. Not just for Blackwater but Graywater as well. Yes, that means you cannot discharge anything. According to the terms of The Longbranch Improvement Club's lease with the Department of Natural Resources, it specifies boats may not release black or grey water into Filucy Bay. Accordingly, NO discharge of any kind will be allowed within the boundaries of this marina. I find it very difficult to go to a marina that has no toilets with running water or showers, and I can't use our sinks or shower on board. Our 43-year-old boat doesn't have a dedicated gray water tank or plumbed, so everything drains into our holding tank. My whole point here is that Filucy Bay is not the last bay, cove or inlet that we enjoy going to that will have these restrictions.

It seems we'll have to start thinking seriously about how we can modify our boats to accept Graywater in one way or another. I know it's just another Environmental thing we need to deal with, but I'm sure, for the health of the beautiful waters we boat in, it's probably best.
